As a Senior Horticulturalist with the University of Alberta Botanic Garden, Emily Neis is responsible for the day to day operations of the Aga Khan Garden and the Patrick Seymour Alpine Garden. Emily will give us a step-by-step guide to creating floral displays for home gardens and community projects. Starting with design ideas and eye-catching colour combinations, we'll learn her tips for best plants to use, best planting practices, and summer care for all season colour.

GRDNetting Solutions. Innovative Ways to Use Netting in Gardens. Sandra Rosler manages the family business, GRDNetting Solutions, located in Airdrie. Urban or rural, large or small, and whatever crops you grow– any of our gardens may be vulnerable to high winds, blazing sun, hungry birds, foraging deer, and voracious insects. Sandra will show us innovative ways to use netting to shield, shade, and protect our gardens. Some GRDNetting products will be on display.
