



Alberta Horticultural Association *Community Gardener Award*

Award & Nomination Information

The Alberta Horticultural Association Education Speaker recognizes that there are outstanding amateur gardeners in or near most communities in our province whose work often goes unrecognized. In an attempt to acknowledge the contributions of these individuals to horticulture in Alberta, the AHA has established a “Community Gardeners Recognition Award”.

- A. The Award will be granted to a person who makes a significant and lasting contribution to a community or its vicinity within the province of Alberta.
- B. The Award will consist of a “diploma” style certificate in colour, suitable for framing, with the individual’s name and the name of the community inscribed thereon, and a letter of congratulations.
- C. If there is an AHA Affiliate Club or Individual Member in or near the community, that club or person will make the presentation on behalf of the AHA. If this is not the case, the Award will be mailed to a named individual who will then arrange for its presentation.
- D. A nomination form must be completed in detail to determine eligibility. The Awards Committee of the AHA will assess the nomination to determine its eligibility/suitability and make the recommendation for either acceptance or rejection of the Nomination to the AHA Executive.
- E. A community or vicinity may only receive one Award per calendar year.
- F. This Award is in no manner related to *Communities in Bloom*.

Procedure

- A. The Application Form must be completed in full. Note that the Application also requires the Contact information of an individual who can verify the contribution to the community or its vicinity.
- B. The Contact person should be an individual “at arm’s length” from the applicant (e.g. Ag Fieldman, Town Administrator, Ag. Society President, etc.)
- C. The application must be submitted to the Secretary of the AHA, at the address given. It will then be processed in the manner outlined above and the person submitting the application will be informed of the decision following the AHA Board meeting subsequent to the application’s receipt.
