Bruderheim & area attractions:

Dennis Maschmeyer Museum (Walker School) 4844 - 52nd Ave
The original four-room schoolhouse was built in 1908 and served the community until 1927 when it was destroyed by fire. A new school was quickly constructed on the same site and now houses the local museum.

Bruderheim Heritage Trail This walking trail, with informational markers, connects Bruderheim's neighbourhoods and scenic sites, allowing visitors to stay active while enjoying the community.

Elk Island National Park

Elk Island National Park is a short ten-minute drive away and a local environmental treasure. Often referred to as "Canada's Serengeti," the park is home to Canada's highest density of bison and elk, second only to the Serengeti Plains in Africa.

Queen's Park

In 1978, Bruderheim was honored with a visit from Queen Elizabeth and Prince Philip, who travelled by train to officially open the Commonwealth Games in Edmonton. To prepare for this occasion, Bruderheim's CNR station site was developed into "Queen's Park," and Main Street was renamed "Queen Street."

Spring Creek Wetland Interpretive Centre

Situated at the east end of 50th Avenue, behind the Town Office, the Spring Creek Wetland Interpretive Centre highlights the importance of wetlands and native plants.

Jurassic Forest (30 minutes away in Gibbons)

Outdoor education center with loop walks in forest dotted with models of multiple dinosaur species.

Ukrainian Cultural Heritage Village (30 minutes away on highway 16)

An open-air museum that features costumed historical interpreters to recreate pioneer settlements.
